



### So...What Are Futures?

- aka Derivatives (bc value derived from the underlying)
- They are <u>not</u> like stocks in some ways
- They <u>are</u> like stocks in other ways
- If you own a stock you own a small piece of a real company & can hold forever
- Stocks don't usually drop to \$0
- If you trade futures you are buying a contract to take delivery of a commodity at a later date
- And you could lose more than your initial investment

# Trading on Margin

- You can buy stocks; and if you want to set up a margin account and the stock is "borrowable" then you can short them
- You will have a margin account if you trade futures: you are borrowing money from the exchange
- What is "shorting"?
- Long is buying in hopes it will go up and you can profit
- Short is selling something you don't own on the promise you'll buy it back later on the hope it will go down

# Chart of "long" Trades




### Chart of "short" Trades



# Why ""

- You can't really trade the Dow Jones Index of 30 stocks
- It's just a measuring stick
- So, to go long and short like that you need a tradable instrument
- These days there is a futures contract called YM that you can trade

# Let's put YM on a Chart



# Why?

- Futures contracts expire on a regular interval, often every 3 months
- In order to view the symbol on a chart you need to know when it expires and use the code for that month & year

### The Reason for this is:

- Futures contracts expire on a regular interval, often every 3 months
- Sometimes more often
- History
  - Futures used to be crops and animals
  - Crops came to market every 3 months
  - Animals were born & matured every 3 months

### Now We Can Look at YM Again

- The current expiration month for YM is June (since March has past)
- And the year is 2021
- So we construct: YMM21
  - YM is the contract
  - M is the month
  - 21 is the year

### What Does "Delivery" Mean?


- In the old days the exchanges physically delivered the commodity to your doorstep
- They still do for some contracts
- But, for others they simply cash you out of your position, win or lose
- Imagine a herd of live cattle (LC) showing up on your doorstep

# RollOver & Expiration

- You MUST remember these dates, so you don't take delivery
- Expiration is the 3<sup>rd</sup> Friday of the 3<sup>rd</sup> month: expiration month (HMUZ)
- RollOver is the Thursday of the prior week
- Traders rollover on this Thursday and begin trading the "front month"

# RollOver Thursday

- I have it on Repeat forever on my phone, with an alarm
- I also have an indicator
- You simply close the contract you are in and buy/sell the next one



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# TASC: Technical Analysis of Stocks & Commodities

- S&P 500 E-Mini is usually the most liquid
- 10-Yr T-Note next
- Nasdaq E-Mini is down at 7th
- YM is at 19<sup>th</sup>
- Don't buy something you can't sell!

### FUTURES LIQUIDITY


Columns indicating percent marginactivity and anotherefore less desirable and effective percent margin provide a helpful comparison for traders who wish to place their margin money efficiently. The effective percent margin. is determined by dividing the margin. value (\$) by the three-year price range of contract dollar value, and then multiplying by one hundred.

#### STOCKS

Trading Equidity has a significant offect on the change in price of a secutity. Theoretically, trading activity can serve as a proxy for trading liquidity. and equals the total volume for a givenperiod expressed as a percentage of the total number of shares outstanding. This value can be thought of as the terrover race of a firm's chance contatonding.

### More About Futures

- When trading stocks, you pay the value shown on the quote
- GOOGL costs \$2,381 per share
- MSFT costs \$247 per share
- Unless you have a margin account where you trade on borrowed money, there is no leverage
- But, futures <u>are</u> leveraged

### How Much Is One Share?

- The S&P E-Mini is at \$4,200
- There are 500 stocks in the index
- 500 \* \$4,200 = \$2,100,000
- So, for \$12,100 you are controlling over \$2 million
- That's just 0.6% you have to put up
- Steep leverage

# Aren't Futures Risky?

- People think that since futures are leveraged you can lose all your money
- Since you are so highly leveraged, you could lose a lot
- If you don't have enough money in your account to cover a loss
- You will have a margin call
- You can lose more than is in your account

# Margin Call

- The broker will call you or send you a notice by email that you have a margin call
- And must bring the account back over the margin rate within (24) hours
- If you are sitting on a losing trade this could amount to a lot of money

### How Much Can I Make?

- The S&P E-Mini is traded at \$12.50 per tick or \$50 per point
- That means if it's trading at 4,200 and it goes to 4,201 (and we are long) we make \$50.
- Next, I'll show you a real live short trade

## A Short Trade



### Does the S&P 500 Ever Go to Zero?

- It hasn't in the 40+ years I've been trading
- If the world came to an end?
- But then you'd have worse problems
- The biggest drop I've experienced was 1,186 points during the Covid Crash, and I was short!
- BUT remember, you can't Hold On To a futures trade waiting for rebound

## You'll Have to Give It Up

- Why can't you hold it forever? (Until it turns around)
- Because it expires every 3 months
- What if the rebound takes a year?

# **Trading Limits**

- There are limits in place to avoid crashes
- From Investopedia:
- A daily trading limit is the maximum price range limit that an exchange-traded security is allowed to fluctuate in one trading session. <u>Limit up</u> is the maximum amount a price is permitted to increase during one trading day. <u>Limit down</u> is the maximum permitted price decline occurring over one trading day. Trading limits are examples of <u>circuit breakers</u>—interventions employed by exchanges to help maintain orderly trading conditions during turbulent markets.

# How I Personally Trade

- The 1<sup>st</sup> things I put on any chart I look at are <u>Attractors</u>
  - I coined the term to describe all kinds of S&R including MAVs where price tends to revert to the mean
- The next thing I put on a chart is my <u>SunnyBands</u> indicator
  - It is based on my <a href="DynamicMovingAverage">DynamicMovingAverage</a> (gold & purple lines) in the center of the bands


### How I Trade: DMA

- The DMA crossover is the macro clue
- But it isn't early enough for me
- So, I created <u>SunnyBands</u> which is faster
- Then I created DMA\_Histogram (DMA\_H) which is even more precise

## Look at the DMA\_H Turns




## That's all there is to it

- I look at the Attractors
- I look at VantagePoint (watch their FREE video)
- I study the DMA
- and the SunnyBands
- I trade the eMini on 1-min & 5-min charts

- With equities, I buy and hold for weeks to months

## Next Step

- With SunnyBands and my DMA\_H on a 1minute chart, I add a 5-minute chart to show me the "long-term" trend
- This is tricky, so refer to my <u>YouTube</u> <u>channel</u> to put 2 SunnyBands with 2 datastreams on one chart




